Stay at the scene

When possible, do not move the vehicle until police arrive. If your car is not in a safe place, move it to a safe place, as close to the accident scene as possible.



Call 911 for help

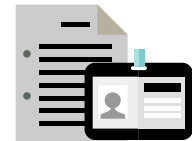
If you are injured and unable to call, tell someone you are injured and to call 911 ASAP.

*Call the police if there's property damage but nobody is injured



Check others for injury

First passengers in your car, then the other vehicles involved. If you haven't already, call 911 for help if anybody is hurt.

Take pictures

Take pictures and videos (if you can, or have someone else do it) Pictures and videos of the accident scene showing the vehicles before being moved are evidence of your version of the events.

Pay attention to:

- Vehicle damage
- Skid mark pictures
